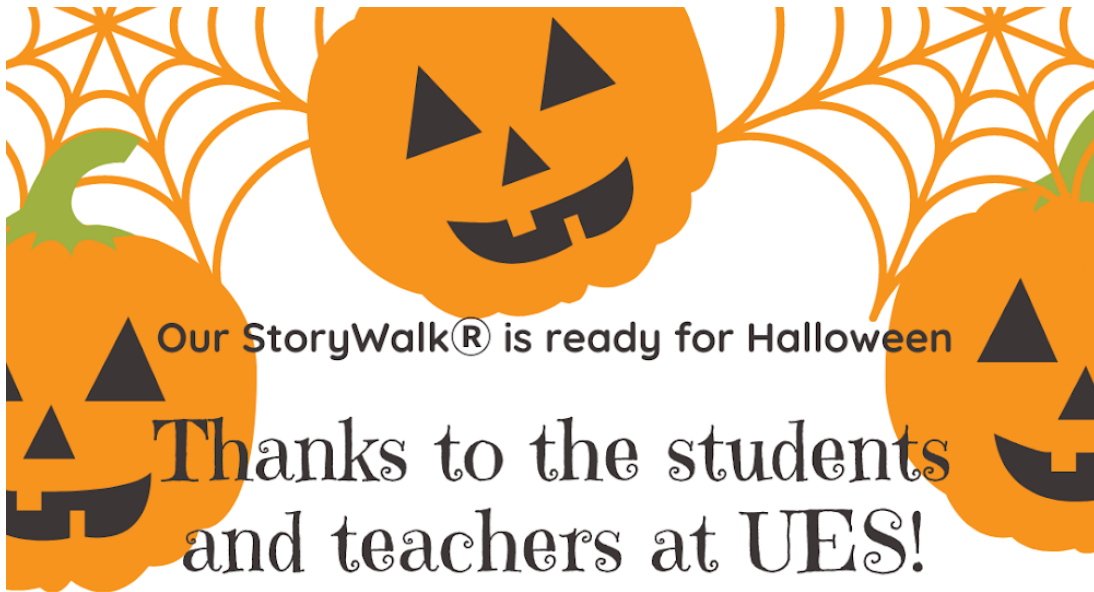

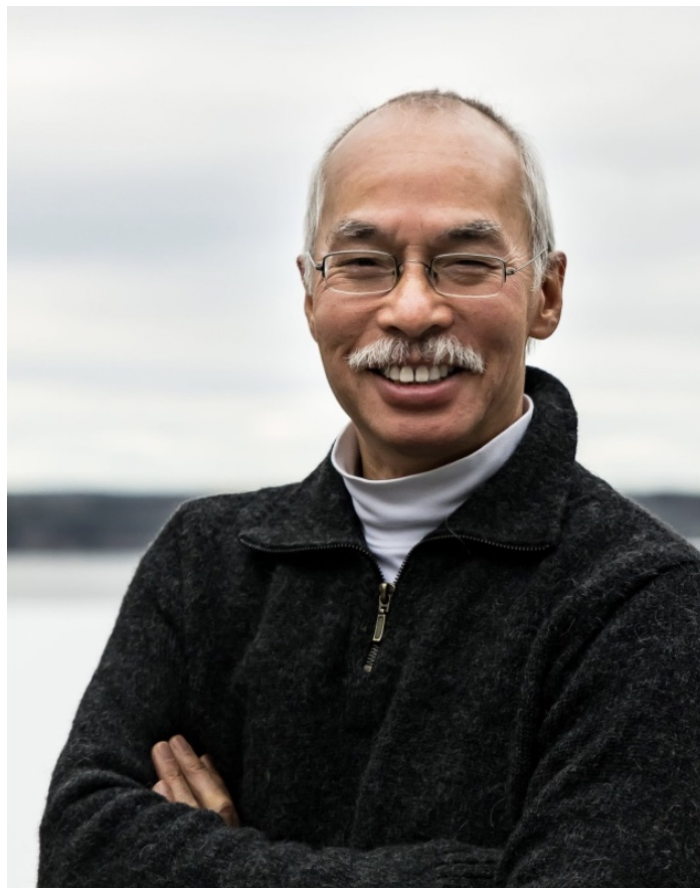
## Tech Tuesday
