**Sand for Seniors** 

"Sand for Seniors" is a program where members of public safety bring a bucket of sand to a senior citizen who is not able to sand their icy walkway on a regular basis due to disability or being home-bound. The program is a collaborative effort that includes Lowe's, the Knox County Deputy Sheriff's Association Lodge of Fraternal Order of Police #700, and local town offices. The program gets a member of public safety in contact with seniors who most likely are in need of services but do not reach out for them.

Qualifying applicants must be 65 years of age or older and show proof of disadvantage by answering some basic questions. These applications may be picked up at Vose Library, the Methodist Church, Come Spring Food Pantry and are available on the Union Town website. Instructions for turning those in are on the form.


# **January Storytime**
