

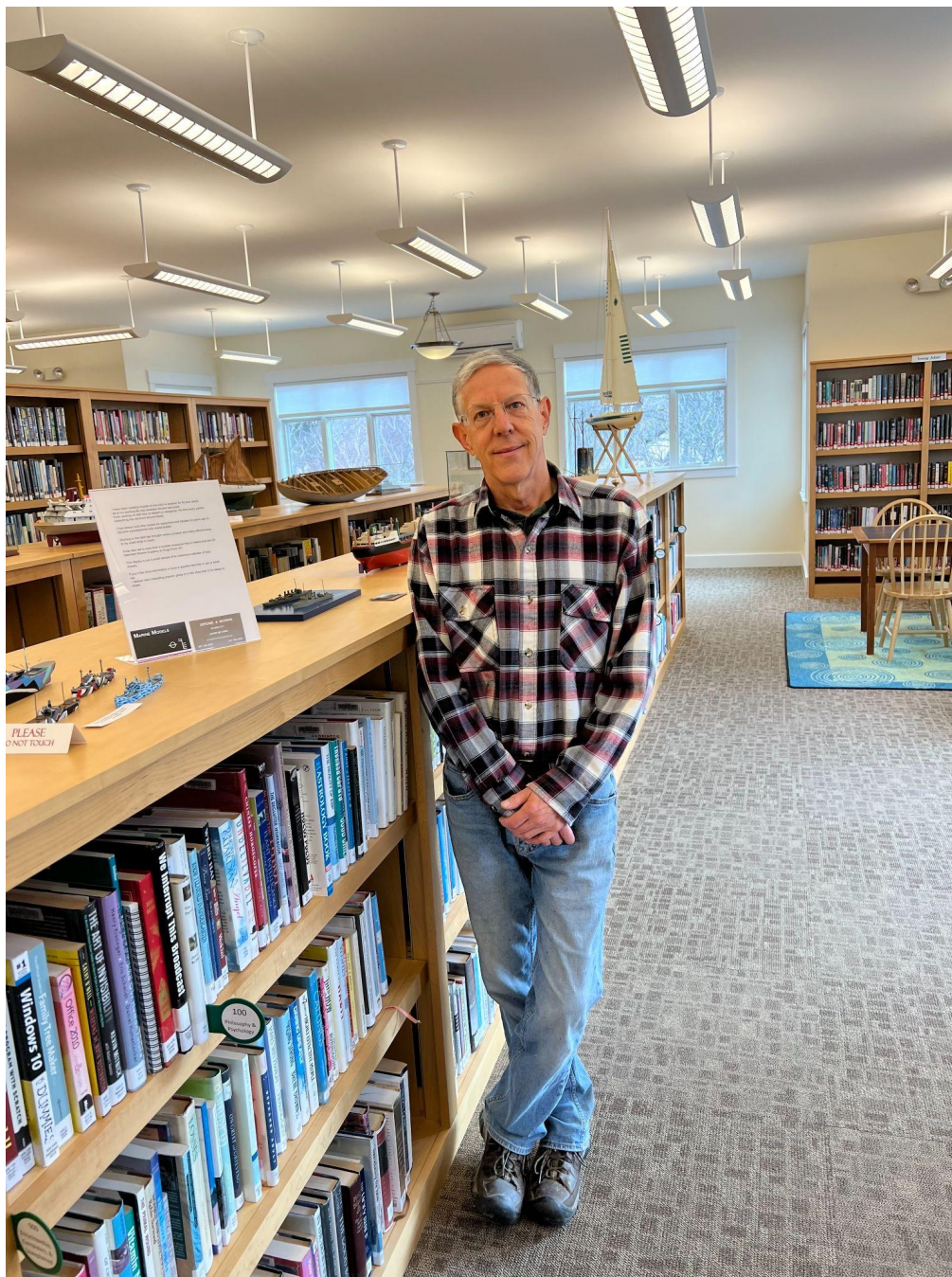

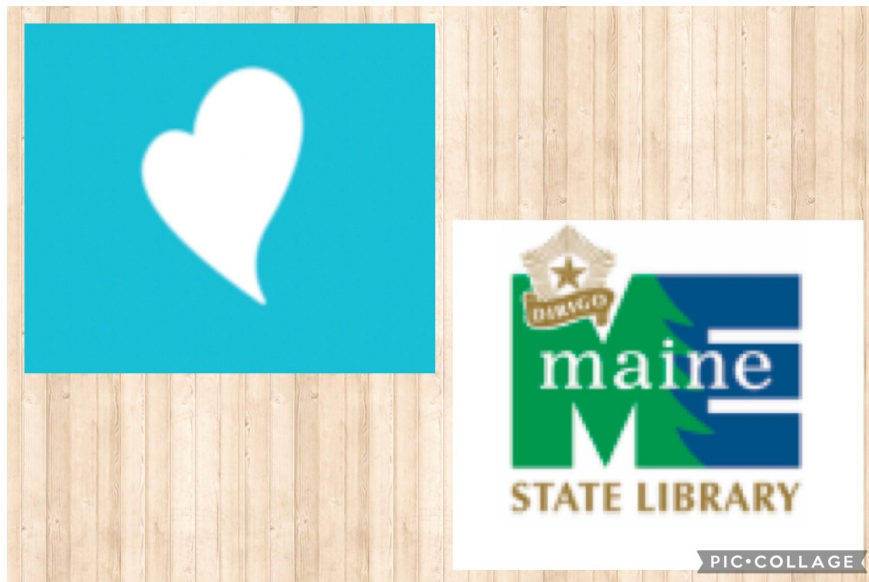
Tuesday, April 5th is our next Tech Tuesday from 6-8pm. We're
